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Content	SIMWARS is on stage-based competition among the healthcare professional which provide platform to evaluate themselves in the simulation by jury. The SIMWARS was the first ever simulation competition took place in Pakistan at Aga Khan University Centre for Innovation in medical Education on 23 February 2019. The competition took place in three rounds. In the first round a quiz, moulage and a suicidal asthma attack scenario. In the second round, a case of women in labor in the community and in the third-round road traffic accident scenario were included. Eight teams participated having a total of five to six members. In the first round all teams participated in a quiz, a suicidal case scenario, Asthma attack and a moulage. The results showed that four teams, namely; CHEETAY, PUMP-IT, TRAUMA TROOPERS, and SIM-NINJAS qualified for the second round. Delivery case scenario was enacted in which two teams CHEETAY and SIM+NINJAS qualified. For the final round a road traffic accident scenario was enacted in which SIM_NINJAS won the competition and CHEETAY was runner up. Each team had Nurses, Doctors health care assistant both Nursing and medical students. We as a nursing student workrd with interdisciplinary team learned how to deal in critical situation in terms of patient safety. It gave chance to apply the theoretical knowledge into practical with prioritizing the patient problem. Moreover, it provides an opportunity to work with inter-professional health care team to develop the communication skills effectively and to evaluate the learned skills.
