Content

Background Transform the current health care model based on comprehensive primary care; with the public health proposal that focuses on prevention, promotion and integrality. A transcendental support is the seven competence of the 2010 curriculum of the medical surgeon degree from UNAM faculty of medicine which the margin says, "Population health and health system: health promotion and disease prevention".
