Title	How to achieve interprofessional education? Possible paths for its implementation in the Faculty of Medicine in the National Autonomous University of Mexico
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	Building the Capacity of Future Leaders in a Socially Accountable World
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Content Interprofessional Education is part of the WHO Human Resources in Health Strategy for Universal Access to Health and Universal Health Coverage. Once applied it provides different benefits like students understand and value each profession, the improvement of communication and outcomes in a health team, and enhance of quality care. However, in the Faculty of Medicine in the National Autonomous University of Mexico there is a lack of clear Interprofessional Education implementation initiatives. That is why, through this work, a bibliographic research is made to select articles about interventions that have been effective in other universities, these with the aim of analyze what could be the paths to be taken by the Faculty of Medicine based on its general context.

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
