Title	Identification of the state of the health maintenance guidelines in the populations attached to the community medicine program of the Juan N. Corpas University Foundation 2019.

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Content	Background. In Colombia, efforts have been made to ensure the comprehensive care of Health. The Ministry of Health developed "Comprehensive care route for the promotion and maintenance of health in the life course of individual and collective character", aimed at promoting health, preventing risk, preventing disease and generating a culture of health care in individuals, families, and communities. Objective. To identify the health condition of population one to five years in a social kindergarten in 2019 ascribed to the Community Medicine program of the Juan N. Corpas University Foundation, according to the health maintenance guidelines. Methods. A descriptive cross-sectional study was carried out in children from one to five years old, who live in Bogotá - Colombia, attended the Social kindergarten during 2019, with records of surveys answered by the parents or childminders ofsted, with consent informed; health status was assessed, sociodemographic and clinical variables expressed in proportions were analyzed. Results. 411 sociodemographic surveys and 390 evaluations of the health status of minors who met the inclusion criteria were included, there is 14.9% risk of overweight, 35.9% risk of short stature for age, 15.9% short stature for age, 22.6% risk of global malnutrition, 31.8% dental caries, 37.2% prevalence of disease in the last month. Conclusions. There are various risk factors that condition minors from one to five years of age to present alterations in their state of health, child malnutrition, oral health, which can lead to the alteration of the growth and development process to children's life cycle.
