Content

Introduction: our public health system has the IMSS which provides care to workers in private companies, ISSSTE which provides care to federal and state public workers in the event of an agreement, while the SSA provides care to the general public through the INSABI. The state of Colima in the primary care level, it is provided the health care attention through the health centers, which are 121, distributed in the 10 municipalities and in 3 health jurisdictions. Objective> with the objective of proposing a program for the primary care level in the area of legal training in bioethics for health personnel, we carried out this work. Material and methods: descriptive qualitative research was carried out over a year. For which we used the following methods: analysis, synthesis, chi square and modeling. A review of regulatory documents of the National Bioethics Commission, bioethics research committees and hospital bioethics committees was carried out. Results: a bioethics training program was designed, which recognizes the importance of establishing a bioethics committee at the primary care level and the importance of having a legal bioethics training system. Conclusions: it concludes with a proposal to improve health care through training in bioethics.
