Content

The Therapeutic Community is an alternative model for the work of patients with psychiatric experiences. Since the end of the seventies, the recommendations of the WHO and OPS in Mexico have promoted this line of work. In the present work, we propose to expose the concept of Therapeutic Community and how this model allows through interdisciplinary work to create possible ways for the social inclusion of this population in Mexico. To this end, we will make a general review of the historical variations that the concept of Therapeutic Community has acquired from the beginning of the 20th century to date in this country. And how this today presents a therapeutic and clinical alternative/tool. This paper aims to describe how time and space are organized in the Therapeutic Community, emphasizing both how the subjects who live in it live, and the clinical body that works in it. The way in which these are linked taking into account the objectives and goals of the community in terms of social inclusion. To conclude by commenting on how, in spite of everything, this device presents some impasses with which it continues to challenge the case by case.
